

GBR CPE Credit Program - FAQ

CPE certification at NS2 NOW Digital Summit 2020 is being administered by Government Business Results, LLC.

Government Business Results, LLC is registered with the National Association of State Boards of Accountancy (NASBA) as a sponsor of continuing professional education on the National Registry of CPE Sponsors. State boards of accountancy have final authority on acceptance of individual courses for CPE credit. Concerns regarding registered sponsors may be submitted to the National Registry of CPE Sponsors through its website: www.nasbaregistry.org.

Q: Are all sessions at NS2 NOW CPE certified?

A: No. Only the sessions offered in the Security & Cloud Tracks are eligible.

Security Track: (3) 20-minute sessions*

- CSO Perspectives
- Securing the Supply Chain

Cloud Track: (3) 20-minute sessions*

- Demystifying Cloud Compliance Standards

- Secure Analytics Cloud (Demo)

Q: Do I need to attend all 6 sessions to receive credits?

A: No. But you must attend all (3) sessions in the same track and meet all the session check-ins to earn 1.2 CPE credits. You do not need to attend both tracks to receive credits.

Q: How does the CPR team know I attended the sessions?

A: There are random check-ins throughout the sessions to ensure attendance. You must be present for all sessions within the CPE designated track and attend each session in its entirety to receive credit.

Q: Is there a separate registration process for the NS2 NOW CPE sessions?

A: No, by registering for NS2 NOW and attending all three sessions in a chosen track, you are eligible to receive CPE credits.

Q: Is there a cost for obtaining CPE credits for the NS2 NOW sessions?

A: The sessions are free of charge to those registered for NS2 NOW.

Q: Are there any pre-work requirements to attend a CPE certified session?

A: No. There are no prerequisites or advanced preparation required for the sessions.

Q: Do I need to bring anything to the session to obtain CPE credit?

A: No. Your attendance to the sessions will be verified through an online mechanism.

Q: How do I receive my CPE credit?

A: After the completion of the session, attendees should visit [NS2 NOW Digital Summit Evaluation and CPE Application](#) and fill out the application. Once your attendance is verified, a copy of your certificate(s) will be emailed to you within 15 business days.
